
Women in the Arts

Maria Tallchief (1925)

As a young woman, Maria Tallchief became the top ballerina in New York City. In 1953, President Dwight D. Eisenhower named her Woman of the Year. In 1980, Tallchief started the Chicago City Ballet.

Mary Cassatt (1844–1926)

Mary Cassatt was a famous painter. She was born in Pennsylvania but spent much of her life in Paris, France. Her paintings of women and children are shown in major art museums.
